

How to Create a Profile on Wikitree

The following screen shots and steps should help walk you through creating a new profile on Wikitree.

Creating a Profile from an already existing Profile

1. If you are adding a new profile to connect to an already existing profile, start by going to the profile of the person that you want to add a person to (such as a parent, spouse, or child).

- Once you have filled out the information you have for your new person, click the “CONTINUE” button
- The next page wants you to confirm certain family connections (*this step will just depend on how and who you connected the new person to when first starting*). i.e. my example is showing that I’m adding Caterina, daughter of Pietro, and wants me to confirm that Pietro’s wife is ALSO Caterina’s parent

10. Once you have put in your information in the source box for your person, click the “PROCEED TO CREATE NEW PROFILE” button
11. This will create the new profile! Great job! When it completes creating the profile, it takes you directly to the “Edit” page for the profile you just created. (*this is new from the recent profile creating update Wikitree pushed. It didn't use to take you to this page*). You don't have to do anything else at this step, unless you want to add some research notes, categories, etc.



Using the Antenati App, Creating a Citation, adding to a Profile

The following steps will show you how to utilize the Antenati app that Greg Clarke created, where to put the source citation so it shows up on the profile in view mode. *These steps assume that you already installed Greg’s Antenati App per his instructions during the January 2023 Connect A Thon.*

- When you’re looking at your desired record in Antenati, you’ll want to click the AntApp button you created when installing/setting up the app per Greg’s previous instructions.



- Once you click that “AntApp” button, the “Antenati Citation Builder” webpage will open up. It auto-fills some data based on the Antenati source you had open when clicking the app.

Adding additional sections to the Biography
